## I want to try it! What do I have to do?

At the moment there are 3 different groups of people who can request access to the DEEP-EST prototype:

- DEEP-EST project members
- EAP project PI (Principal Investigator): The person who wrote the EAP proposal
- EAP project member: People who are invited by the PI to join an EAP project

EAP project PIs and members have to sign the Usage Agreement and the PI has also to sign the Principal Investigators Agreement.

Each EAP application will be counted as one project (regarding accounting, ressources, disk space, etc.).
